

ANNEXURE A – CERTIFICATION POLICY

Certification Policy

Certification of documents may be performed by any of the following authorised persons:

- A lawyer, notary, actuary, or accountant holding a recognised professional qualification;
- A serving police or customs officer (except in South Africa);
- A member of the judiciary;
- A senior civil servant;
- An employee of an embassy or consulate of the country where the identity documentation was issued;
- A director of a regulated financial services business in Mauritius or an equivalent jurisdiction; or
- A Commissioner of Oaths.

The certification must clearly state that the document is a true and accurate copy of the original. It should include the following information regarding the certifier:

- Full name;
- Signature;
- Capacity or position;
- Address; and
- Contact details, including telephone number.

Additionally, the certification must be dated to indicate when it was performed.
